NBLL Air Quality Policy

North Boise Little League will follow the Idaho DEQ "recommendations for schools".

- Green and Yellow Air Quality Index (AQI) will not be cause for any change in NBLL practices or games.
- Orange AQI, at practices NBLL coaches will increase rest periods and substitutions and reduce the number of strenuous activities. An Orange AQI will have no impact on scheduled NBLL games.
- <u>Red AQI</u>, at practices NBLL coaches will decrease the number of strenuous activities (drills), have more frequent and longer rest periods, and consider shortening the length of practice. A Red AQI will have no impact on scheduled NBLL games.
- Purple AQI will result in cancellation of practices
 As well as NBLL games. Players with asthma or other
 respiratory /cardiovascular illness should be monitored at all
 times regardless of the AQI. If a parent chooses to remove
 their child from participating in an NBLL practice or game
 because of a concern for their health, there will be no
 repercussions from either the coach or the league,
 regardless of any specific team rules. Extended absences for
 "health concerns" will require that the player's parents furnish
 the coach with a signed doctor's release BEFORE the
 player will be allowed to return to practice.
